Geriatric and Addiction Psychiatry Fellowship Applicant Requirements

- Applicants must have completed training at a fully accredited ACGME General Psychiatry Training Program in order to begin the Fellowship.
- Applicants must pass the USMLE Step 2 prior to application, and successful completion of USMLE Step 3 is strongly encouraged.
- Applicants are required to submit a completed application packet of the following:
 - Application with Photo
 - Curriculum Vitae
 - Personal Statement
 - Official Medical School Transcript
 - Copies of USMLE Step I, II, III Score Reports
 - ECFMG Certificate (if applicable)
 - Copy of J-1 Visa (if applicable)
 - Copy of Medical School Diploma
 - Training Director Letter
 - 3 Additional Letters of Recommendation from Attending Supervisors
 - Copy of State License, DEA and DPS Certificates (if applicable)
- After completed applications are reviewed by the Education Committee, applicants may be invited to interview with the Fellowship Faculty.
- Please note that Indiana University School of Medicine will only sponsor J-1 visas.
